

Allen Springs

16 sites, All Year, All ages, Tents, 30 ft. max RV length.

This facility has 16 sites that are nestled along the Metolius River. The circular shape of the campground means most of the campsites are better suited to tents rather than RVs. Allen Springs is a No Water campground so campers will need to bring their own supply. Each site is equipped with a picnic table and fire pit. We do have vault toilets onsite. There is also a small picnic area onsite.

Allingham Campground

10 sites, Apr-Oct, All ages, Tents, 50 ft. max RV length

Allingham Campground can accommodate RV, trailer or tent-campers however water and electric hookups are not available. All sites are equipped with a picnic table and campfire ring with grill and the campground has vault toilets and drinking water available.

Black Pine Springs Campground

free, all ages, Tents, 4350 ft. elev. all facilities removed

Black Pine Springs Campground offers dispersed campsites near Sisters Oregon. The campground is halfway between Sisters and Three Creek Lake and can be used as overflow when campgrounds on the lake are full or closed. The campgrounds offers no amenities. Pack out your trash.

Blue Bay Campground

25 sites, May-Sep, All ages, Tents Only sites:

Blue Bay Campground offers standard sites that accommodate both tents and RVs, but no hookups are available. Picnic tables and campfire rings with grills are provided, as are vault toilets and drinking water.

Camp Sherman Campground

15 sites, May-Sep, All ages, Tents, 40 ft. max RV length

Camp Sherman Campground offers a handful of standard sites for both tent and RV camping, and one tent-only site. Each sites is equipped with a picnic table and campfire rings. Vault toilets and drinking water are provided, but electrical hookups are not available. Showers are available in the town of Camp Sherman, less than 2 miles from the campground.

Canyon Creek Campground

7 sites, May-Sep, All ages, Tents, 2900 ft. elev. toilets

Lower Canyon Creek Campground can accommodate RV, trailer or tent-campers however water and electric hookups are not available. This is a no water facility so campers will need to bring their own supply. All sites are equipped with a picnic table and campfire ring with grill and the campground has vault toilets available.

Cold Spring Campground

23 sites, Apr-Sep, All ages, Tents, 50 ft. max RV length

There are 23 single campsites in this facility. Water is available by hand pump and there are three vault style toilets. Each site is equipped with a picnic table and fire ring. With a loop road, bicycling throughout the campground is a favorite pastime for families that come to Cold Springs Campground.

Graham Corral Horse Camp

13 sites, May-Oct, All ages, Tents.

There are 13 sites in this campground. Sites 4, 5, 7, and 8 have four-stall corrals. All other sites share the large corral. Livestock water is available but campers will need to bring their own supply of drinking water. All sites are equipped with a picnic table and campfire ring with grill and the campground has vault toilets available.

Gorge Campground

Can accommodate RV, trailer or tent-campers however water and electric hookups are not available. This is a no water facility so campers will need to bring their own supply. All sites are equipped with a picnic table and campfire ring with grill and the campground has vault toilets available.

Indian Ford Campground

25 sites, May-Sep, All ages, Tents sites: 25, 45 ft. max.

Indian Ford Campground can accommodate RV, trailer or tent-campers however water and electric hookups are not available. This is a no water facility so campers will need to bring their own supply. All sites are equipped with a picnic table and campfire ring with grill and the campground has vault toilets available.

Jack Creek Campground

18 sites, May-Oct, All ages, Tents, 35 ft. max RV length

Jack Creek Campground can accommodate RV, trailer or tent-campers however water and electric hookups are not available. This is a no water facility so campers will need to bring their own supply. All sites are equipped with a picnic table and campfire ring with grill and the campground has vault toilets available.

Link Creek Campground

33 sites, Apr 23-Nov 30, All ages, Tents, 45 ft. max RV

Link Creek Campground offers tent and RV campsites, as well as yurts. Campsites are equipped with tables and campfire rings with grills. Vault toilets and drinking water are provided. Electrical hookups are not available. While the campsites are pet-friendly, unfortunately pets are not permitted within the yurts. The yurts are available for reservation year-round. Each is equipped with a bunkbed with one double and one single mattress, double futon, table and chairs and a wood stove. Visitors need to bring their own linens, lantern and eating essentials. No electricity is available.

Lower Bridge Campground

12 sites, May-Oct, All ages, Tents, 36 ft. max RV length

Lower Bridge Campground can accommodate RV, trailer or tent-campers however water and electric hookups are not available. All sites are equipped with a picnic table and campfire ring with grill and the campground has vault toilets and drinking water available.

Monty Campground

7 sites, All Year, No RVs, All ages, Tents Only Camp, 29

Pine Rest Campground is one of our few tent-only facilities so we cannot accommodate RVs or trailers. This is a no water facility so campers will need to bring their own supply. All sites are equipped with a picnic table and campfire ring with grill and the campground has vault toilets available.

Pioneer Ford Campground

20 sites, May-Oct, All ages, Tents, 2750 ft. elev. water

With 20 campsites Pioneer Ford Campground is well-suited to trailers, tents or RVs with its mix of back-in and pull-through sites. Many sites are right along the Metolius River and site 8 also has an adjacent picnic shelter. This facility has vault toilets as well as drinking water available. Each site is equipped with a fire ring and picnic table.

Riverside Campground

16 sites, May-Sep, No RVs, All ages, Tents Only Camp

Riverside Campground is one of our few walk-in tent-only facilities therefore we cannot accommodate RVs or trailers. Campers must haul their camping gear a short distance to the camping site. All sites are equipped with a picnic table and campfire ring with grill and the campground has vault toilets available.

Round Lake Campground ...

free, All ages, Tents, fish, primitive, fire damaged 2003, facilities removed, dispersed camping now, heavy deer activity

Sheep Springs Horse Camp

11 sites, May-Oct, All ages, Tents, 50 ft. max RV length

The campground offers 11 large equestrian sites, each equipped with a 4-place box stall. Picnic tables, campfire rings and grills and ample room for parking vehicles and trailers are also available at each site. Drinking water and a vault toilet are also provided.

Sisters Cow Camp Horse Camp

free, 5 sites, May-Oct, All ages, Tents, 40 ft. max RV length

Maintained and operated in cooperation with the Central Oregon Chapter of Oregon Equestrian Trails, this five site campground offers early season access to the Metolius Windigo Trail. Sisters Cow Camp Horse Camp does not offer reservations through Recreation.gov.

Sisters Creekside Campground

67 sites, Apr 8-Nov 1, all ages, Tents,

Creekside Campground is a municipal park which offers a total of 60 camp sites including 27 full hook-up sites plus a separate "hiker/biker" area. Each site is equipped with a fire pit and a picnic table. The campground has restrooms and coin operated showers as well as an automated sewer discharge site.

Creekside Campground is situated along Whychus Creek and within walking distance of downtown. A covered foot bridge spans the creek and leads to Creekside Park. Smiling River Campground

Smiling River

Campground offers sites that accommodate both tent and RV camping, however hookups are not available. Picnic areas, trails and scenic overlooks, along with the conveniences of firewood, drinking water and flush toilets, give visitors the opportunity to enjoy the outdoors while still having many of the conveniences of home.

South Shore Campground

39 sites, May-Sep, All ages, Tents, 40 ft. max RV length.

Each site has a gravel parking spur, picnic table and campfire ring. Dump stations are dispersed through the campground. Drinking water and vault toilets are provided.

Three Creek Lake Campground

10 sites, Jul-Sep, All ages, Tents, 20 ft. max RV length

Three Creeks Lake Campground can accommodate RV, trailer or tent-campers however water and electric hookups are not available. This is a no water facility so campers will need to bring their own supply. All sites are equipped with a picnic table and campfire ring with grill and the campground has vault toilets available.

Three Creek Meadow Campground

10 sites, Jun-Sep, All ages, Tents, 6350 ft. elev. toilet

Three Creeks Meadow Campground can accommodate RV, trailer or tent-campers however water and electric hookups are not available. This is a no water facility so campers will need to bring their own supply. All sites are equipped with a picnic table and campfire ring with grill and the campground has vault toilets available.

Three Creeks Meadow Horse Camp

9 sites, Jun-Sep, All ages, Tents, toilets

Three Creeks Meadow Horse Camp which is designed for horse campers only; be advised there may be horses in the area. Sites 001-011 are for regular camping and the adjacent horse camp sites 012-020 are for horse camping only.

Whispering Pine Horse Camp

9 sites, May-Oct, All ages, Tents, 40 ft. max RV length

Located eleven miles west of Sisters, Oregon, off Highway 242, Whispering Pine Horse Camp provides early season access to trails and is perfect for horse lovers who are visiting nearby friends. This rustic nine site horse camp offers great riding opportunities and trail access to the Three Sisters Wilderness Area. There are nine sites in this campground and each can accommodate up to four horses. Livestock water is available as well as vault toilets, but campers will need to bring their own drinking water.
